Supporting 2 applications to manage electronic forms for human resource processes including posting, hiring, onboarding and offboarding. Districts can assign and track documents, electronically sign forms, and centrally monitor it all online.

Implement and support new and existing data management systems that enhance regional services.

WNYRIC is supporting an add-on PowerSchool application to enhance districts' use of the system. Report Creator allows districts to create templates for report cards, transcripts, and custom reports. Districts can now publish report cards to the parent and teacher portals for easy access and to save on printing/mailing. Also included is Attendance Monitor that allows districts to set attendance thresholds and notify parents of excessive absences based on the district's policies. Communication can be done through the Parent Portal, and attendance dashboards are available at district-, school- and student-levels.
