

The Arts in Education (AIE) programs provide arts and arts-integrated learning experiences for K-12 students and teachers. All learning experiences are based on the NYS Standards for the Arts. Arts and cultural resources (museums, libraries, historical sites, performing arts centers, arts organizations and teaching artists) partner with schools to provide performances, workshops, residencies, or staff development. Using FTE support in conjunction with our partners, Erie 1 BOCES staff can help support student and staff learning in a multiple day experience, both onsite and in the classroom for students to participate in collaborative intensive arts learning.

PROGRAMMING INFORMATION

What does my district need to know in order to participate in this program?

- Districts must participate in the Arts in Education coser (447). Partner districts may participate at any time. A 12.5% fee is charged for service.
- Arts in Education costs are reimbursed the next school year based on the districts NYS aid ratio.
- All costs are covered aside from food and transportation.
