Attendance Closeout Defaults Please make sure that a new attendance closeout default has been created for each individual building under Student > Attendance > Attendance Closeout Defaults. There should be a default created specifically for the 2024-25 school year, typically with a date any time after 08/01/2024. When you select the most recent default and click "search", you will want to verify that every grade and every daycode in use has a closeout default assigned (either a specific period or a percent of the attendance), as well as making sure that "daily attendance" box is checked.

eSchoolData Calendars

Make sure your calendar has been set up for the 2024-25 school year. Don't forget to run your daycodes. Make sure to review the dates for your marking periods (both calendar and grade entry), as well as any progress reports (if applicable).

Back to School Troubleshooting Tips and Tricks



If a teacher cannot see their Roster, check that they have "Current Students" chosen If a teacher cannot take Attendance, make sure they are on the "Attendance" or "Seating Chart" screen -Attendance cannot be saved on the "Roster" screen

If the icons on the toolbar do not show, make sure the right arrow is pointing up
