Updates:

2021-22 and 2022-23 Regents Examination Scores to Satisfy Diploma Requirements: According to NYSED, there will be no new codes or exemption grade to be added electronically. Districts will not substitute a failing grade with a grade of SA on the student's transcript. The appeal will be done outside of SIRS the same way current appeals are done. Districts can utilize the Transcript Comment under the Transcript Override Tab to indicate if a student is receiving credential due to the Appeal. Please see attached FAQ document provided by NYS.

Grade Advancement: Please make sure to review the documents sent by your Grade Advancement Contact from our team and setup a date for your District's grade advancement (July 11 – July 22, 2022).

2022-23 School Setup and Calendars: If you have not yet completed the [school setup forms](#) for each of your buildings within your district that take attendance (elementary, middle schools, high schools, UPK and parent taught buildings), please complete these forms ASAP. It is imperative that the setup is completed before Grade Advancement in July, and they need to be setup for your district calendar contacts to be able to enter in marking period dates as well. Any schools that do not have their forms completed by June 30, 2022, will have their school setup run by default of having courses without sections copied over from the 2021-22 School Year.



Calendar assistance for the 2022-23 School Year is available during one-on-one workshops where Dale Kivett (DKivett@e1b.org) or JoAnna Wallace (JWallace@e1b.org) will walk you through adding events, daycodes, and marking periods. It is advised that your school setup is completed for all your buildings before scheduling an appointment, reach out by email for availability.

US History Framework Regents Exam: Following the cancellation of the regent's framework exam, we would like to remind you to remove the Regents event from your June Calendars. Please feel free to reach out for assistance.

SBRCs: If your district is requesting any SBRC changes for the 2022-23 school year, please **submit them by June 30, 2022** to ensure there is time to make the changes and allow for review before the new school year. Delays in receiving the changes may result in delaying grade entry open dates for elementary buildings in the fall.
